



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: How many stages are there and how many days?**

**A: There are 30 stages planned over 3 days with the longest ones at 20kms long**

**Q: What types of stages are in the Adelaide Rally?**

**A: The stages are very technical with low average speeds and a high number of corners per kilometre. They are regarded as true drivers roads. They also feature nearly 90% guardrailing, clear space or embankments on corners meaning the event is almost entirely Grade A stages with high safety levels.**

**Q: What is the Speed Limit for the Outright Competition Category and the Challenge Category?**

**A: Outright Competition is 200kph although the stages have been designed with tight corners such that top cars will only reach 180kph. Challenge Category is limited to 130kph.**

**Q: For the Challenge Category (130kph limited category) what are the basic requirements?**

**A: National Rally Licence, Full National level apparel including a Hans Device and suit etc. The car needs a 6 point cage with single door bars as a minimum. Check the Supp regs and the Further Regulations for details. Turbocharged cars don't need to run restrictors. Winged seats needed. Cars with over 3.8 litre capacity need to fill out a vehicle identity form to gain further information on the car. Cars can't be on the ineligible vehicle list. **Q: What cars are excluded under Motorsport Australia's vehicle ineligibility list for both the 200kph and 130kph categories?**

**A: Cars with a 0-100kph time less than 3.6 seconds as well as the following cars:**

**Q: For the Outright Competition (200kph limited category) what are the basic requirements?**

**A: Full Tarmac Spec Cage with Sainz bars, Double door bars, cross in roof and cross in hoop or rear members as detailed in supp' regs. Winged seats. Plumbed in fire system. Crew need to upgrade from National Rally to a new Category A Tarmac Licence at \$0 free upgrade for 2023. This requires a medical assessment much like a circuit licence. Crews must do a \$75 online safety course that can be booked here:**

**All turbo 4wd cars must run a restrictor and only 2wd cars with modified turbos must run a restrictor. Cars with a capacity over 3.8 litre must fill out a vehicle information form to gain further information on the car.**

**Q: What is the experience criteria for this years Adelaide Rally and the Challenge 130kph and Competition 200kph categories?**
